Vispo Allegro Prosecco Spumante ^{VG}

Bottle £28.00 – 200ml £8.00

Veneto, Italy

Delicate and complex bouquet with fruity notes reminiscent of peach and green apple. Fresh and light on the palate with balanced acidity.

Nyetimber Classic Cuvee ^{VG}

Bottle £68.00

Sussex, England

Whether it's toasting a birthday or simply finishing a busy week this fizz is utterly delicious. Possibly, no definitely, one of the best English sparkling wines money can buy.

Nyetimber Brut Rose ^{VG}

Bottle £80.00

Sussex, England

Nyetimber Rose has a vibrant pink colour, with finely formed small bubbles. Flavours of currants, wild strawberries and buttery pastry add layers of richness to this amazing sparkling wine.

WHITE WINE

Alaja Blanco

Bottle £22.00 – 175ml £5.25 – 250ml £7.60

Jumilla, Spain

Made with equal parts Macabeo and Airen, this wine is delicately fresh with gorgeous fruity flavour.

Vida Loca Branco

Bottle £25.00 – 175ml £5.95 – 250ml £8.60

Portugal

Fresh, fruity aromas, tropical fruits, passion-fruit and citrus standing out. Mineral. Round and very pleasant finale. Pair with grilled fish, seafood and white meats, but also ideal served as an aperitif.

Little Cricket Gruner Veltliner

Bottle £27.00 – 175ml £6.50 – 250ml £9.30

Hungary

Usually identified with Austria, this fabulous wine gives a real challenge to the over supplied Pinot Grigio's and Sauvignon Blanc's of today. Fresh and lively with aromas of lemon and apple. Light-bodied with nice acidity. Dry, clean, and crisp with citrus notes, yellow plum, light green apple and a hint of white pepper.

Beau Flamant Picpoul de Pinet

Bottle £32.00

South of France

Crisp, bright and refreshing. Lemon zest and underlying minerality. The perfect seafood match.

Allan Scott Estate Sauvignon Blanc ^{VG}

Bottle £36.00 – 175ml £8.60 – 250ml £12.50

Marlborough, New Zealand

Fresh, zesty, juicy and full. Gooseberry and herbaceous notes. A classic NZ Sauvignon.

Domaine Seve, Macon Village

Bottle £45.00

Burgundy, France

A spectacular, wine bursting with fresh apple aromas and hints of tropical fruits. Slightly buttery on the palate with a good acidity. A great all-rounder that works with both fish and white meats.

Domaine Fernand Girard Sancerre

Bottle £55.00

Loire, France

Focused and intense Sauvignon Blanc from the Loire with aromas of citrus, mineral and stone. The palate is precise, bright, filled with zesty crisp lemon and lime and balanced with a gorgeous underlying acidity and pure minerality.

ROSÉ WINE

Post Tree Pinotage Rosé ^{VG}

Bottle £22.00 – 175ml £5.25 – 250ml £7.60

South Africa

An elegant Rosé bursting with flavours of fresh strawberries and ripe cherries, but without the cloying sweetness of an average Rosé.

Cote Mas Rosé ^{VG}

£28.00 – 175ml £6.70 – 250ml £9.70

South of France

Very light and refreshing with a delicate pear-drop fruit. Bright and fresh.

AIX Provence Rose, Maison Saint Aix

Bottle £42.00

South of France

The nose is fresh and fragrant, delicate yet youthful and offers classy notes of watermelon, strawberries and flowers.

RED WINE

Bushranger Shiraz ^{VG}

Bottle £22.00 – 175ml £5.25 – 250ml £7.60

Australia

A deliciously fruity red, full of classic ripe red fruit and berry flavours, with an added touch of Shiraz spice on the finish.

La Vaca Gorda Malbec ^{VG}

Bottle £25.00 – 175ml £5.95 – 250ml £8.60

Mendoza, Argentina

Deep and vibrant Malbec with an intense nose of plum, damson and dark chocolate aromas. Lush and layered on the palate, with well-integrated oak and plenty of fine tannins. Drink with beef in all its guises.

Il Folle Nero d'Avola

Bottle £28.00 – 175ml £6.70 – 250ml £9.70

Sicily, Italy

Full-bodied, gorgeous aromatics of blackberry liqueur and vanilla. The King of Sicily.

Next Station Douro Tinto

Bottle £31.00 – 175ml £7.40 – 250ml £10.70

Portugal

The steep, exposed vineyards of the Douro Valley are cooled by the river running through it and it deliver juicy, aromatic reds. Expect rich notes of blackberry, hints of wild thyme, a generous palate and soft tannins.

Lyrarakis, Liatiko IGP 'Queen' Red ^{VG}

Bottle £38.00

Crete, Greece

Impressive aromas of dark cherry and wild berries with flavours bursting deep and pure on the palate. Intense and balanced with fine tannins and an expressive juicy finish.

Casina Bric, Mesdi Rosso

Bottle £45.00

Piemonte, Italy

Mesdi Rosso is 100% Nebbiolo and an amazing introduction to the stunning wines of Piemonte and such ridiculously good value! A light ruby colour in the glass with orange tints. Aromas of rose petals and sweet spices with notes of dark chocolate. On the palate, fresh and fruity with moderate tannins and a balanced acidity.

Sons of Eden, 'Kennedy' Grenache Shiraz Mourvedre ^{VG}

Bottle £56.00

South Australia

Bursting with ripe cherry, blackcurrants and five-spice aromas. The palate is a delicious blend of red-fruit flavours and savoury undertones supported by a rounded and fleshy mid palate. The wine finishes with excellent length and freshness.

DESSERT WINE

Hidalgo, Pedro Ximenez Triana

500ml Bottle £38.00 – 100ml £8.00

Sanlucar, Spain

Pedro Ximenez is made from sun-dried grapes and left for many years in oak casks to mature. It is a dark, rich and opulently sweet sherry wine with a dried plum flavour as well as chocolate molasses, butterscotch and raisins on the nose. Satisfying luscious finish with plenty of honeyed toffee.

Chateau Filhot, Sauternes

Half Bottle £48.00 – 100ml £13.50

Bordeaux, France

Honey, crème caramel, luscious stone fruits; excellent acidity; long elegant finish. A classic pairing with blue cheese, tarte tatin or delicious just as an aperitif or digestif.

Kopke 10 year old Tawny Port

Bottle £50.00 – 100ml £7.00

Portugal

Kopke 10 Year old is lusciously smooth with complex notes of sweet spice and rich dried fruits balanced alongside honey and subtle wood. An endlessly long finish, this is a great choice with an array of desserts from chocolate brownies to crumble. The perfect after-dinner digestif!
