## SPARKLING WINE

### Vispo Allegro Prosecco Spumante <sup>VG</sup>

Bottle £29.00 – 200ml £9.50

Veneto, Italy

Delicate and complex bouquet with fruity notes reminiscent of peach and green apple. Fresh and light on the palate with balanced acidity.

### Tarlant Brut Nature Zero Champagne <sup>VG + BIO</sup>

Bottle £75.00

Champagne, France

Superb family run Champagne House using biodynamic viticulture principles offering long term and sustainable biodiversity within the vineyard. Brut Nature = Zero added sugar, this is a frank and fresh Champagne. A blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier and Pinot Noir. Scents of honey, wax, lemon and mandarin with a long, pure and fresh citrus finish.

### Nyetimber Brut Rose <sup>VG</sup>

Bottle £80.00

Sussex, England

Nyetimber Rose has a vibrant pink colour, with finely formed small bubbles. Flavours of currants, wild strawberries and buttery pastry add layers of richness to this amazing sparkling wine.

## WHITE WINE

### Customs House Airen-Macabeo <sup>VG</sup>

Bottle £23.50 – 175ml £5.75 – 250ml £8.25

La Mancha, Spain

Made with equal parts Macabeo and Airen, this wine is delicately fresh with gorgeous fruity flavour.

### Vida Loca Branco

Bottle £26.50 – 175ml £6.50 – 250ml £9.25

Portugal

A blend of Portuguese white grape varieties. Unoaked retaining the fresh vibrancy of the grapes. The Vida Loca White is clean with citrus, standing out passion-fruit and tropical fruit notes.

### Little Cricket Gruner Veltliner

Bottle £29.00 – 175ml £7.00 – 250ml £10.00

Hungary

Usually identified with Austria, this fabulous wine gives a real challenge to the over supplied Pinot Grigio's and Sauvignon Blanc's of today. Fresh and lively with aromas of lemon and apple. Light-bodied with nice acidity. Dry, clean, and crisp with citrus notes, yellow plum, light green apple and a hint of white pepper.

### Beau Flamant Picpoul de Pinet

Bottle £34.00

South of France

Crisp, bright and refreshing. Plenty of lemon zest with an underlying minerality.

### Allan Scott Estate Sauvignon Blanc <sup>VG</sup>

Bottle £36 – 175ml £8.60 – 250ml £12.50

Marlborough, New Zealand

Fresh, zesty and juicy. A classic NZ Sauvignon, full of gooseberry and herbaceous notes.

### Domaine Seve, Macon Village

Bottle £46.00

Burgundy, France

A spectacular wine bursting with crisp apple and hints of tropical fruits. Slightly buttery with a good acidity.

### Domaine Fernand Girard Sancerre

Bottle £55.00

Loire, France

Focused and intense Sauvignon Blanc from the Loire with notes of zesty citrus, mineral and stone. Precise and balanced with a gorgeous acidity and pure minerality.

## ORANGE WINE

### Casa Balaguer-Vinessens, Tragolargo Moscatel <sup>VG + O + LS</sup>

Bottle £44 – 175ml £10.50 – 250ml £15.25

Spain

A natural, cloudy, organic blend of Moscatel and Malvasia from Alicante. A bright amber colour is given by the short skin contact of the grapes. Dry and fresh, very fruity, slightly funky as expected from an orange wine, with pretty floral notes, apricot, melon and nectarine.

## ROSÉ WINE

### Post Tree Pinotage Rosé <sup>VG</sup>

Bottle £23.50 – 175ml £5.75 – 250ml £8.25

*Swartland, South Africa*

An elegant Rosé bursting with juicy flavours of fresh strawberries and ripe cherries.

### Cote Mas Rosé <sup>VG</sup>

Bottle £29.50 – 175ml £7.25 – 250ml £10.25

*South of France*

A delightful Rosé that's light, crisp and fruity. It offers lovely cherry and blackcurrant fruit notes.

This wine is full-bodied and balanced.

### AIX Provence Rose, Maison Saint Aix

Bottle £42.00

*South of France*

The nose is fresh and fragrant, delicate yet youthful and offers classy notes of watermelon, strawberries and flowers.

## RED WINE

### Bushranger Shiraz <sup>VG</sup>

Bottle £23.50 – 175ml £5.75 – 250ml £8.25

*South East Australia*

A deliciously fruity red, full of classic ripe red fruit and berry flavours, with an added touch of Shiraz spice on the finish.

### La Vaca Gorda Malbec <sup>VG</sup>

Bottle £26.50 – 175ml £6.50 – 250ml £9.25

*Mendoza, Argentina*

Deep and vibrant Malbec with intense plum, damson and dark chocolate notes.

Lush and layered with well-integrated oak and plenty of fine tannins.

### Capofeto Nero d'Avola

Bottle £29.50 – 175ml £7.25 – 250ml £10.25

*Sicily, Italy*

Full-bodied, gorgeous aromatics of blackberry liqueur and vanilla. The King of Sicily.

### Next Station Douro Tinto

Bottle £31 – 175ml £7.50 – 250ml £10.75

*Portugal*

The steep, exposed vineyards of the Douro Valley are cooled by the river running through delivering juicy, aromatic reds.

Smooth and complex with rich notes of blackberry, plum and cassis with hints of wild thyme and violet.

### Chateau Ollieux-Romanis, Lo Petit Fantet De L'Hippolyte <sup>VG + O + LS</sup>

Bottle £38.00

*Languedoc, South of France*

A soft, rich and fruity blend of Carignan, Grenache and Syrah. Black cherry, thyme and wood-spice gives way to

warming garrigues flavours. Only natural yeasts are used and no sulphur is added. The label was designed by the

Vignerons' young son Hippolyte, who is often to be found amongst the vines. The name translates from Occitan as 'the

little wine that is the little child of the little child Hippolyte.

### Casina Bric, Mesdi Rosso <sup>OP</sup>

Bottle £45.00

*Piemonte, Italy*

If you're a fan of Barolo styles, this will be a wine to try! Mesdi Rosso is 100% Nebbiolo, a blend of two vintages,

organically grown grapes on an estate high in the Langhe. An amazing introduction to the stunning wines of Piemonte, a

fun and approachable example. Rose petals and sweet spices with notes of dark chocolate.

Fresh and fruity with moderate tannins and a balanced acidity.

### Sons of Eden, 'Kennedy' Grenache Shiraz Mourvedre <sup>VG</sup>

Bottle £56.00

*Eden Valley, South Australia*

Classic blend of old vine Barossa Grenache, Shiraz and Mourvèdre. Named as a tribute to the legendary Barossa

Vignerons' who pioneered the planting of the old treasured vineyards. Bursting with ripe cherry, blackcurrants, five-spice

and savoury undertones. An excellent length and real freshness.

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## DESSERT WINE

### **Hidalgo, Pedro Ximenez Triana**

**500ml Bottle £38.00 – 100ml £8.00**

*Sanlucar, Spain*

Pedro Ximenez is made from sun-dried grapes and left for many years in oak casks to mature. It is a dark, rich and opulently sweet sherry wine with a dried plum flavour as well as chocolate molasses, butterscotch and raisins on the nose. Satisfying luscious finish with plenty of honeyed toffee.

### **Chateau Filhot, Sauternes**

**Half Bottle £48.00 – 100ml £13.50**

*Bordeaux, France*

Honey, crème caramel, luscious stone fruits; excellent acidity; long elegant finish. A classic pairing with blue cheese, tarte tatin or delicious just as an aperitif or digestif.

### **Kopke 10 year old Tawny Port**

**Bottle £50.00 – 100ml £7.00**

*Portugal*

Kopke 10 Year old is lusciously smooth with complex notes of sweet spice and rich dried fruits balanced alongside honey and subtle wood. An endlessly long finish, this is a great choice with an array of desserts from chocolate brownies to crumble. The perfect after-dinner digestif!
